

Kanchenjunga Base Camp Trek

Trip Overview

Experience a remarkable Adventure Trekking in Nepal with the Kanchenjunga Base Camp Trek, one of the most Popular **Trekking Destinations in Nepal**. This challenging trek takes you to the base of the world's third highest mountain peak, offering an unforgettable experience in one of Nepal's most remote and pristine regions. Located near the eastern border of Nepal with India, the base camp lies within the protected region of Kanchenjunga Conservation Area. **Kanchenjunga Trek** begins with a scenic flight from Kathmandu to Biratnagar, followed by a drive to Taplejung. Kanchenjunga Base Camp Trekking in Nepal lets you enjoy traversing through the less-traveled trails along the Kanchenjunga region, providing serene solitude and true exploration. You'll also be able to witness the pristine beauty of Kanchenjunga Glacier (one of the largest glaciers in eastern Himalayas of Nepal), Yalung Glacier, Milung Glacier and its surrounding icefalls showing the dramatic beauty of the Himalayas. A sacred Hindu pilgrimage site located off the main trekking route, Pathibhara Devi Temple is a spiritual, holy and devotional point for devotees across Nepal and India, which attracts many believers across the countries.

Along the way, you'll be able to experience the rich culture of Kirat, Rai, Limbu, Sherpa, and Tibetan communities as you pass through the traditional village settlements as they are the communities primarily residing in eastern Nepal and the Sikkim and Darjeeling regions of India. While traveling you'll be able to gaze at the diverse landscapes of the region, ranging from high altitude cliffs and mountains to lush rhododendron and bamboo forests, and you'll be able to marvel at the breathtaking scenic panoramic vistas of heavenly mountains such as Kanchenjunga (8,586m), Jannu (Kumbhakarna), Kabru and many more! This trek in Nepal also offers trekkers the opportunity to encounter the endangered species including red pandas, snow leopards, Himalayan black bears, Bluesheep and many other such rare wildlives in the Kanchenjunga Conservation Area.

Kanchenjunga Base Camp trekking itinerary typically spans for around 20-25 days, starting from Kathmandu. Taking a flight to Biratnagar then driving to Taplejung. Drive to Sekathum via Chiruwa, and trek firstly starts from Sekathum to Ghyabla then to Ghunsa for acclimatization continue to Kambachen and Lhonak, reach Pangpema (Kanchenjunga North Base Camp). After reaching there you'll be able to explore and witness the grand vistas of Kanchenjunga. The return trek takes you through Selele (Mirgin-La) Pass before descending to Taplejung. This trek in Nepal concludes its journey with driving back to Biratnagar and taking a return flight to Kathmandu.

The cost for this adventure trekking in Nepal varies depending on several factors such as group size, duration and services included. The cost of trekking in Nepal to Kanchenjunga base camp covers permits, guide and porter services, accommodation in Kathmandu and during the trek, meals during the trek, domestic flights and transportation. This Kanchenjunga Base Camp Trekking itinerary cost is reasonable in a sense that all the services included in the trek itinerary provided by our company are of top-notch quality and best of our services.

As the trekking involves challenging high altitude passes and long days of hiking, this trekking in Nepal is suitable for experienced trekkers, culture enthusiasts, adventure enthusiasts and photographers, who have good physical health and are accustomed to high-altitude trekking and strenuous physical activity. The best time to climb this popular trekking destination in Nepal is during the Spring (April-May) and Autumn and Pre Winter (October-December) seasons, when the weather is stable, making it easier to pass through high passes and enjoy panoramic mountain views.
