The route to return is the same as well, and the view will remain just as beautiful from the opposite side as well. This most famous trekking route has a maximum altitude of 5,364 meters. On the EBC trekking, other snow-capped mountains in the Himalayas such as [Ama Dablam](#), Pumori, Nuptse, and Thamserku peaks can be seen as well. Everest Base Camp Trekking can be trekked all around the year, but the busiest or most crowded season is spring, and because of the sunny days, the weather is warmer and dry making the scenery clearer and sharper. The months in which people generally climb or trek to Everest Base Camp Trekking are May and September, which is to avoid the harsh winter snows and summer monsoon rains.
