Helambu is renowned for Buddhist pilgrimages. The monasteries reflect the Buddhist artistic and historical significance. Helambu is also known as **Beyul Hyolmo** (Beyul means Sacred Valley) and is the homeland of the Hyolmo people, who all follow Buddhist practices. That's why the wildlife is especially protected, due to the peaceful Buddhist communities in the higher mountains. The Helambu trekking trail is less crowded, and nature continues to surprise with its beauty.

The Ganja La Pass Trek is one of the most diverse treks close to the Kathmandu Valley. It's a very challenging camping trek, but rewarding, with natural sights and rich Buddhist culture.

Day10: Trek from Sherpa Gaun to Syabrubesi (1465 mts)

Day11: Drive Syabrubesi to Kathmandu
