

Ganjala Chuli Peak Climbing

Trip Overview

Ganja La Chuli Peak climbing, at 5863 m, also called Naya Khang Peak, is one of the best peaks to climb in the Jugal Himal Range, located on the border of Sindhupalchok and Rasuwa districts in Nepal. This is suitable for anyone who is seeking a 5800- to 6500-meter peak in Nepal. This particular trekking destination is closer to the capital city of Kathmandu, yet it is the least traveled and most adventurous trekking trail. Ganjala Peak climbing requires technical skills, climbing equipment, and physical fitness. The summit of Naya Kanga Peak offers spectacular panoramic views of mountains in Nepal and Tibet, including Shisapangma (8027m), Langshisha Ri (6412m), Salbachum (6715m), Langtang Lirung (7,227m), Pema Thang Karpo Ri (6865m), Yala Peak, Ganesh Himal, Rangem Boudha Himal, and Gauri Shanker. The approach to Ganjala Peak is through the Langtang Valley, surrounded by appealing mountain peaks. Climbing this peak is mixed with an adventure walk through the forest of Langtang National Park, the second-largest national park in Nepal. Ganja la peak climbing also offers the exploration of Tibetan-style Tamang villages and their cultures.
