

# Dhaulagiri Expedition

## Trip Overview

Dhaulagiri I Expedition is one of the best expeditions in Nepal; the Mt. Dhaulagiri is situated in western Nepal; at an altitude of 8,167m from sea level. Dhaulagiri is derived from the Sanskrit word 'Dhavalā', meaning white and 'Giri' meaning Mountain, hence Mount Dhaulagiri means "the white mountain". Mount Dhaulagiri is ranked seventh highest mountain in the world and sixth highest mountain in Nepal. Dhaulagiri is also counted among the fourteen peaks in the world for having an elevation of 8000m and the main Dhaulagiri is probably the easiest Nepalese eight-thousanders though ranked the seventh highest mountain in the world. Mount Dhaulagiri is one of the remarkable and most in demand eight thousanders in Nepal despite being a little more remote. Since climbing Dhaulagiri is not technical, Dhaulagiri is an idyllic option for beginner mountaineers and the best season to climb this mountain would be Spring/Autumn. Dhaulagiri was first sighted in the early 1800s by the British surveyors and one of the Indian surveyors and was considered the highest mountain at that time. The pundits mapped it in 1873 but the mountain became popular in 1949 after a Swiss aerial survey was made. Following from the Northeast ridge, Mount Dhaulagiri was first climbed by the Swiss in 1960. The mighty Dhaulagiri is incredibly beautiful and its expedition is also the most famous expedition in the world full of adventure and excitement. The peak of the mountain extends thirty miles providing structure to an otherwise twisted landscape of twisting ridges, glaciers and ice fall. Along the main crest, several pyramid shaped peaks rise in addition to the main summit all of which rise more than 25,000 feet altitude and each peak rises over the Kali Gandaki gorge to the southeast in about 30 km of horizontal distance. Mount Dhaulagiri, along with Mount Annapurna, makes Kali Gandaki the deepest gorge. The Kali Gandaki gorge stands between Dhaulagiri and Annapurna therefore gives an exclusive example of two Eight-thousander massive mountains facing each other over a deep Kali Gandaki valley. A trek in Dhaulpur region through wild and beautiful landscape is tranquil yet filled with both excitement and adventure.
