

# **Bokta Peak Climbing**

Bokta Peak climbing is one of the very best climbs in the Kanchenjunga area in the category of 6000m peaks. Bokta peak is situated 6114m above sea level. Bokta peak is located in Taplejung district of eastern Nepal close to the third highest mountain in the world – Mt. Kanchenjunga. Bokta Peak stands tall at an altitude of 6143 meters above sea level. The west side of this peak is straight up and technical. There is no straightforward path on the east side of this peak and the most appropriate path is north of the mountain. The route follows the snow slope while the slope is quite vertical and vulnerable to rock fall. Listed as group “A” climbing peak by NMA, Bokta Peak receives fair amount of climbers yearly therefore making it a less crowded climbing choice. This adventurous trekking peak is not often climbed and also it has not been long since the peak was permitted to climb under the authorization of Mountaineering Association of Nepal. Permits have been issued only since 2002. In a year, only a fair number of people climb this peak therefore, it is less crowded. Bokta peak is one of the adventurous peaks and climbing this peak is not so easy but if you are someone looking for an exciting adventure in a less remote part of the Himalayan range, Bokta Peak is definitely the perfect place for you. Climbing to Bokta Peak is an excellent opportunity to view the glorious sights of Mt. Kanchenjunga, Kumbhakarna or Jahnu, Karbu Range including several adjoining high peaks. Bokta Peak climbing is truly an exciting experience. The pleasure of exploring the less beaten path and well-preserved natural wonders of Kanchenjunga region with the flourishing valleys, attractive wilderness, awe-inspiring scenery and intermingling with welcoming locals is something you cannot describe in words.
