

Lobuche west peak climbing

Trip Overview

Lobuche West Peak climbing is situated at 6135m elevation from sea level. Lobuche West Peak lies in the Khumbu Himal Range of the Everest region. Classified as “A” category climbing peak by NMA, Lobuche peak also known as Lobuche, the Mountain consists of two different peaks: Lobuche East & West Peak, at an elevation of 6090m and 6135m respectively. An irregular and continuous ridge connects these two peaks but there is a large distance between them. Both these peaks are spectacular and very similar in geometry; shaping a three-ridged pyramid on each, Lobuche East however is 45m (148ft) higher than east. Lobuche west peak climbing is also not easy trekking peaks in Everest region. This peak is more challenging & technical than the Lobuche East. Although, there is significant distinction in the East and West Lobuche trek, while trekking to Lobuche West, we come across many of the same places as to Lobuche East, like: Namche, Tengboche, Dingboche, Lobuche. Basically, Lobuche West peak climbing follows Everest base camp trekking trail from Lukla leading to Lobuche West base camp. There are many small peaks in Lobuche West and to reach the actual peak, you need to climb vertical snow and ice slopes from the top ridge. We will have to use the equipment to overcome the challenging sharp ridges and snow areas. When you climb Lobuche west, the natural exploration of the region grips you totally. The attractive nature of the region is contributed by wildlife, lakes and rivers, mountain landscape, alpine settlements and forests. All of these are stunning and strikingly amazing sights to see. We can also take pleasure in cultural exhibits and get familiar with the lifestyles of ethnic groups like: Sherpa and Rai of this region. The view also embraces Everest, Nuptse, Lhotse, Makalu, Cho-Oyu, Ama Dablam, and more and on the way back from the peak, you can have a choice to progress towards Gorak Shep and Kala Pattar from where the magnificent views of Mighty Everest can be observed. Best season for Lobuche west peak climbing is from March to May and from September to December.
